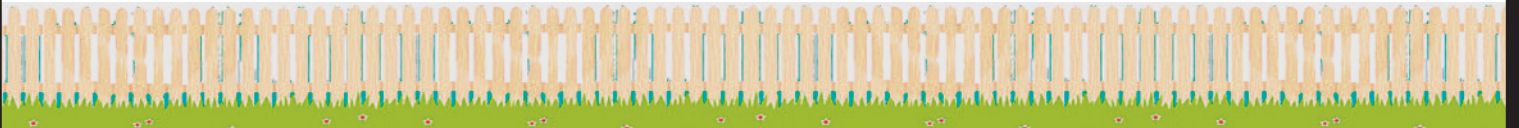


In ur backyard: The Health Risks of Nuclear Power
